Copyright Case: Matchroom Boxing Ltd v BT Plc, United Kingdom

The court granted a blocking injunction requiring a number of internet service providers to block their customers' access to streaming servers where copyright infringements were taking place through the unauthorised streaming of live footage of sports events.
